

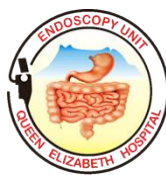

## FACULTY BIODATA



**Professor Dr Rajvinder Singh** Australia

Dr Rajvinder is a Professor of Medicine with the University of Adelaide and the Director of Gastroenterology at the Lyell McEwin & Modbury Hospitals, South Australia. He has special interest in advanced endoscopic imaging techniques and endoscopic treatment of premalignant and malignant lesions in the gastrointestinal tract. Over the last 10 years, he has published an average of 10 papers and 1 book chapter per year (Total overall: > 100 peer reviewed papers and 10 book chapters). Rajvinder is an Editorial Board member of Endoscopy and Co-Editor of World Journal of Artificial Intelligence in Gastroenterology, and was a past Editorial Board member of Digestive Endoscopy and Endoscopy International Open. He is a committee member of the Standards of Practice and Publications committee with the World Endoscopy Organisation (WEO).

**Dr Mohan Kumar Ramchandani** India

Dr Mohan has a long experience of 20 years in the field of Gastroenterology. He is currently Director of Interventional Endoscopy at AIG Hospitals, Hyderabad and adjunct faculty at Manipal Academy of higher education. He is expert in advanced procedures like third space endoscopy, Spyglass Cholangioscopy, ERCP, Endoscopic ultra Sound (EUS), Enteroscopy etc. His special interest is third space endoscopy. He is active in GI endoscopy societies and presently is the national Joint Secretary of society of GI endoscopy of India and member of American society of GI endoscopy.



**Dr Pradermchai Kongkam** Thailand

Dr. Pradermchai Kongkam currently serves as the current director of the Excellence Center for GI Endoscopy, King Chulalongkorn Memorial Hospital (KCMH), Bangkok, Thailand. He is also an assistant director of the KCMH. He is currently a Fellow of the American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ASGE). Prior to that, he was the President of the Thai Association for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy from 2018 to 2021 and the Deputy Head of Research in the Department of Medicine at Chulalongkorn University from 2017 to 2021. His work is also internationally recognized as he serves on the editorial boards of the Endoscopic Ultrasound Journal.

**Dr Yip Hon Chi** Hong Kong

Dr Yip is currently an associate professor in department of Surgery in The Chinese University of Hong kong and an Honorary associate consultant in division of Upper Gastrointestinal and Metabolic surgery in Prince of Wales Hospital. He has special interests in endoscopic detection, diagnosis and endoscopic resection of early pharyngeal, oesophageal and gastrointestinal carcinoma, minimally invasive surgery for locally advanced oesophageal and gastric cancer, and application of robotics in endoscopic surgery. He is also very active in publications of research as well as book chapters.



**Dr Partha Pal** India

Dr Partha is currently a consultant Gastroenterologist & Inflammatory Bowel Disease specialist of Asian Institute of Gastroenterology, Hyderabad. He graduated as gold medalist from North Bengal Medical College, and further his training of fellowship in Gastroenterology in Asian Institute of Gastroenterology. He was the recipient of the Torrent Young Scholar Award (TYSA) in 2017 – All India 1st (Gastroenterology). His areas of interest are IBD, pancreatic disease, small bowel disease and therapeutic endoscopy.

### Datuk Dr Ryan Ponnudurai Malaysia

Datuk Dr Ryan is board certified in Gastroenterology from the USA, having done his residency at the Cleveland Clinic and fellowship at Scripps Clinic in La Jolla California. He then spent a year in interventional endoscopy at the Wellesley Hospital in Toronto and EUS training with Professor Soehendra in Hamburg, Germany. Upon returning to Malaysia, he spent six years at the Selayang Hospital pioneering the teach of EUS in Malaysia. Ryan has chaired the Asia Pacific Task Force in EUS since 2011. This has been a vehicle of hands-on training in EUS for specialists in the region. He has been invited to numerous live endoscopy workshops and has written book chapters and published in peer-reviewed journals.



### Datuk Dr Jayaram N S Menon Malaysia

Datuk Dr Jayaram is currently a Consultant Gastroenterologist and Physician at the Pantai Hospital Ayer Keroh, Melaka. He was formerly Head of the Department of Medicine and Gastroenterology Unit in Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Kota Kinabalu, Sabah (1990-2017). He was a former National Head of Gastroenterology and former National Head of Internal Medicine at the Ministry of Health, Malaysia. He was instrumental in initiating the Post-basic GI Endoscopy Nursing Programme in Malaysia in 2009. His interests are in Upper GI bleeding, ERCP and the development of Endoscopy nursing.



### Professor Dr Lee Yeong Yeh Malaysia

Dr Lee is a Professor of Medicine and Consultant of Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Internal Medicine of University Sains Malaysia. He is currently the Editor of BMC Gastroenterology, PeerJ, Journal of the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh, and the Malaysian Journal of Medical Sciences. He has published 300 papers in high-impact journals including Gastroenterology and Gut, several book chapters, and numerous conference proceedings. Among his current research interests include gut microbiota, neurogastroenterology, functional gastrointestinal disorders, gastroesophageal reflux disease, obesity, and endoscopy. He is a committee member of the World Gastroenterology Organization (WGO), OESO, and American Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ASGE), and the Scientific Chair of Asia Pacific Digestive Week (APDW) 2020. He is recently elected as a fellow of the Academy of Sciences of Malaysia (FASc) in 2022.



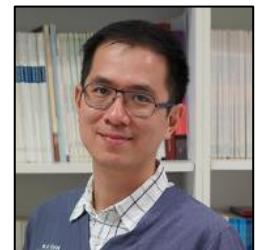
### Associate Professor Dr Ho Shiaw Hooi Malaysia

Dr Shiaw Hooi Ho is an Associate Professor of Medicine and Senior Consultant Physician and Gastroenterologist in both the University Malaya Medical and Specialist Centres. He is active in promoting the use of image-enhanced endoscopy and endoscopic submucosal dissection (ESD) both in the detection and management of early gastrointestinal (GI) neoplasia and cancer. In his routine endoscopy work, he performs numerous other diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopies such as peroral endoscopic myotomy (POEM), submucosal tunneling endoscopic resection (STER), biliopancreatic endoscopy, small bowel enteroscopy, etc. He is an associate editor of the BioMed Central Gastroenterology and an international advisor of the Advances in Digestive Medicine, both are peer-reviewed journals. He is a councillor member of the Asia Pacific Society of Digestive Endoscopy (APSDE) and a Fellow of the Japan Gastroenterological Endoscopy Society (JGES). He is also a faculty member of both the Asia Pacific Endoscopy Research Forum (AERF) and the Asian Novel Bio-Imaging & Intervention Group (ANBIIG).



### Professor Dr Chan Wah Keong Malaysia

Dr Chan is a Professor of Medicine and Consultant Gastroenterologist in University of Malaya Medical Centre. His areas of expertise are diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopy, viral Hepatitis B and C, hepatocellular carcinoma and non-alcoholic fatty liver disease. # 1<sup>st</sup> EndoQE 2014 – “THE THINKING ENDOSCOPIST”

The Gastroenterology Unit of the Queen Elizabeth Hospital (QEH), Kota Kinabalu in collaboration with the Ministry of Health Malaysia organised the First Sabah International Endoscopic Ultrasound (EUS) and Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangiopancreatography (ERCP) hands-on workshop on 5<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> December 2014 in the QEH.

Graced by renowned EUS experts, both local and international, this two-day workshop with the theme “The Thinking Endoscopist” was conducted with the aim of training and familiarising endoscopists with the fundamentals of the EUS and ERCP. This event was put together by course director, Datuk Dr Raman Muthukarupan and his team. The invited faculty members comprised Dr Arthur Kaffes and Dr Saurabh Gupta from Australia and Datuk Dr Ryan Ponnudurai, Mr Krishnan Raman and Dr Mohd Rizal Roslan from Malaysia. The event was enriched with discussions among the expert panel on difficult cases as well as short lectures.



This workshop was attended by gastroenterologists from all over Malaysia, and witnessed a wide spectrum of cases ranging from TB of the liver to pancreatic malignancies. The integration of didactics, live cases and hands-on experience under the guidance of the experts allowed the participants to enhance their knowledge and technique in EUS and ERCP.

QEH is the only hospital in East Malaysia that provides EUS services. The Endoscopy Unit was established in 1998 by Datuk Dr Jayaram Menon and has since evolved into a training centre of excellence in the Ministry of Health (MOH). The services offered in the centre range from upper and lower endoscopy (OGDS and Colonoscopy), small bowel enteroscopy, capsule endoscopy, ERCP (Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangiopancreatography) and Endoscopic Ultrasound (EUS).



# EndoQE 2015 – “THE BORNEO ENDOSCOPY ADVENTURE”

EndoQE 2015, the 2nd Sabah International Endoscopy Workshop, was held from 10th to 13th September 2015. This prestigious live endoscopy workshop was organised in collaboration with MSGH, EUS-TAP and WIGNAP.

The distinguished faculty included the world famous Dr Nageshwar Reddy and Dr David Carr-Locke. The other faculty members were Dr Benedict Devereaux, Dr Ryan Ponnudurai, Dr Roy Soetikno, Dr Rajvinder Singh, Dr Christopher Khor, Dr Sharmila Sachithanandan and Dr Payal Saxena.

EndoQE 2015 was a huge success attracting 415 participants from throughout the country. The highlights of this meeting were Spyglass Cholangioscopy, interventional EUS, a hands-on workshop in EUS and ERCP, Advanced Endoscopy Imaging, a GIA workshop and state-of-the-art lectures.

For the first time in Malaysia, POEM was performed on one of our patients with achalasia cardia. This was carried out by Dr Payal Saxena. It was a great teaching experience for all the delegates. There was also a number of patients on whom Spyglass Cholangioscopy were performed. These were carried out by Dr David Carr-Locke and Dr Nageswhar Reddy. Many of our patients and local endoscopists benefited from this live endoscopy workshop.

The GI fellows had a good learning experience from the hands-on EUS and ERCP workshop, doing cases supervised and aided by world renowned endoscopists.

The Advanced Endoscopy Imaging Workshop by Dr Rajvinder on the last day attracted trainees and local endoscopists from both public and private sectors. This session was highly successful and many benefited from this session. This workshop mainly dealt with colonic polyps NBI and EMR in addition to Barrett’s Esophagus.

Overall this live endoscopy workshop, the first of its kind in East Malaysia, brought esteemed endoscopists led by the legendary Dr David Carr-Locke and Dr Nageshwar Reddy to the shores of

Sabah to teach and share their lifetime experience in various aspects of endoscopy. It was a memorable endoscopy workshop which will stay in everyone’s hearts and minds forever.

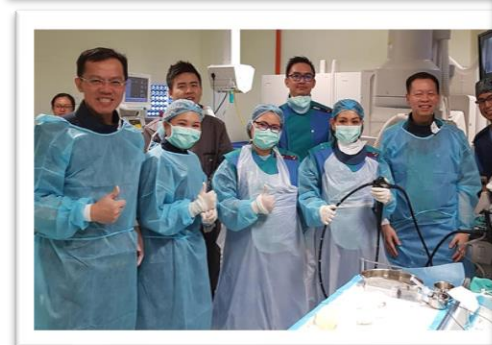
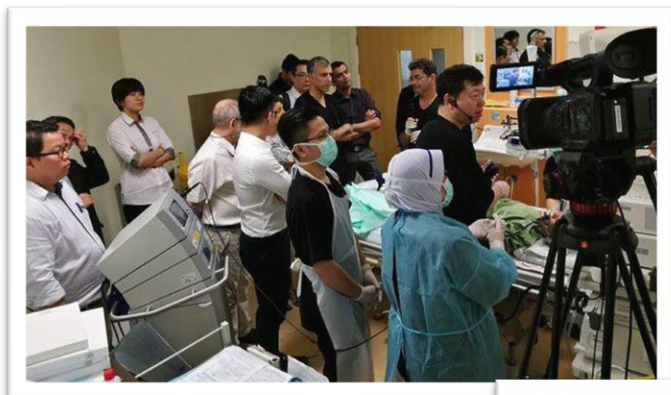
The hands-on workshop benefitted immensely GI fellows who carried out procedures under the guidance and supervision of our distinguished faculty members.

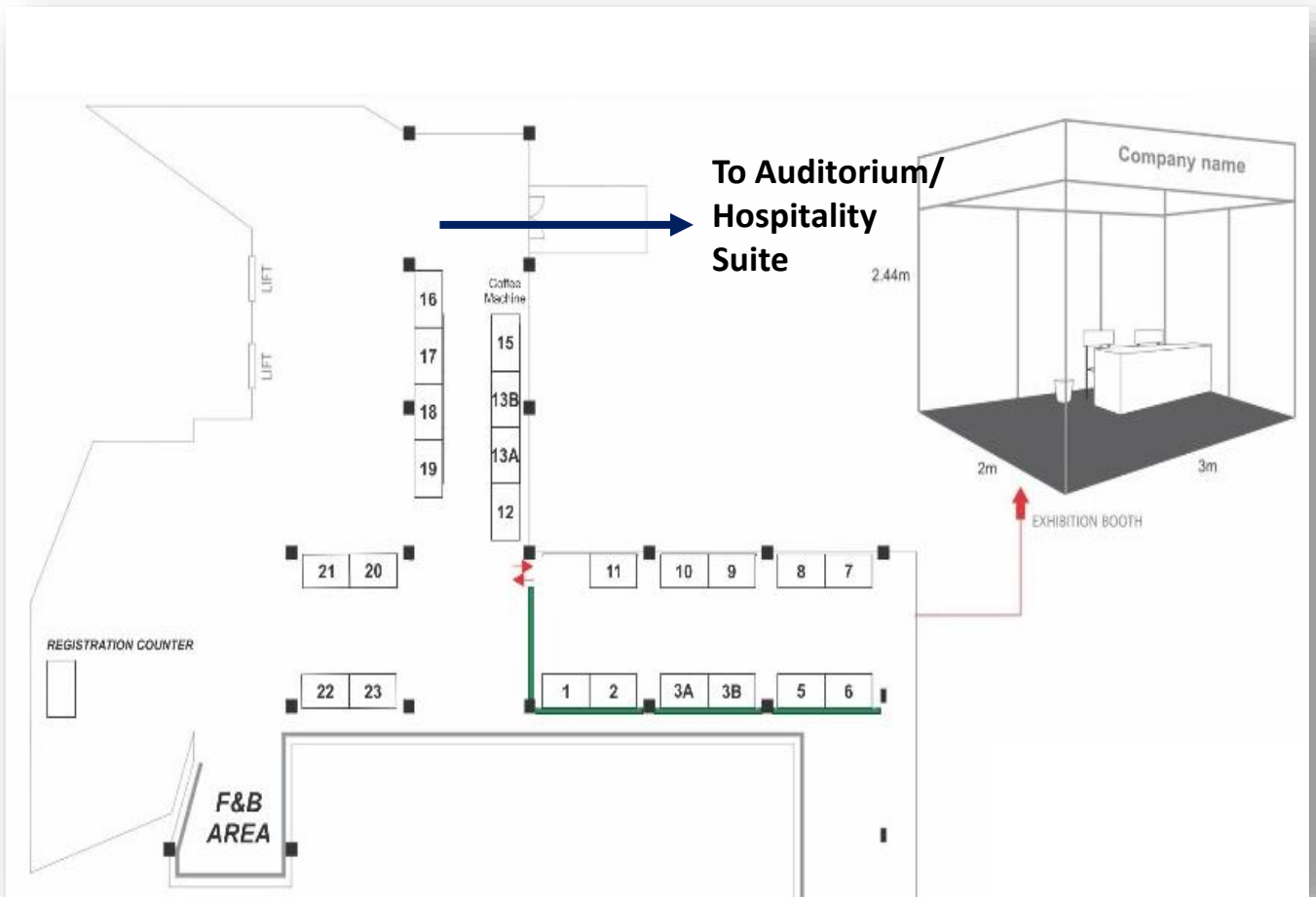
