## Objectives and Format of Workshop

He is currently Director of Shivanand Desai Center for Digestive Disorder, Deenath Mangeshkar Hospital and Research Center, India. He completed his fellowship in gastroenterology in Mumbai, India before pursuing his further training in advanced endoscopy in various countries namely Germany, Austria, France and China. He had been invited to various international conferences as a speaker including ACG annual meeting, APDW, DDW, and WGO annual conference. Dr Amol has a great deal of interest in research and publications. He has more than 50 publications and was involved in writing three book chapters. He has received various awards international including 'Pioneer in Gastroenterology' award by World Endoscopic Organization. His special expertise is Endoscopic Submucosal Dissection (ESD) and he has made an effort for enlightenment of ESD in Japan and other countries as well. He developed the first water-jet emitting endo-knife: Flush knife (Fujifilm) in 2005 and also has published articles to arrange the methodology of ESD. He is passionate in promoting ESD all over the world and challenge the limits of therapeutic endoscopy.



### **Stephen Tsao** Singapore

Associate Professor Dr Stephen Tsao is a Consultant Specialist in Gastroenterology at Raffles Hospital, Singapore. He graduated from the University of Leicester, UK in 1996. He undertook basic medical training in University Birmingham, UK and obtained his MRCP in 2000. He later returned to University of Leicester and completed his higher specialist training in Gastroenterology and General Internal Medicine in 2008. Associate Professor Tsao's subspecialty interest is in advanced diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopy (EMR, ESD and POEM). He was awarded with the Japanese Society of Gastroenterology Fellowship in 2010 and he is also the Course Director of Singapore International Advance Therapeutic Endoscopy Course (SIATEC). Associate Professor Tsao has been very active amongst the local gastroenterology fraternity where he has served in different positions in the Gastroenterology Society of Singapore (GESS) and is currently the President-Elect.

## Goh Khean Lee Distinguished Endoscopy Lecture

*Introduction by Professor Dr Sanjiv Mahadeva*

It is only befitting, on the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Live GI Endoscopy Workshops at the Universiti Malaya Medical Centre, that we acknowledge and honour the individual who has been solely responsible for the development and conduct of these workshops since its inception. Emeritus Professor Dato' Dr Goh Khean Lee, or "KL Goh" as he is famously known within the GI medical fraternity both nationally and internationally, is himself an outstanding leader in the field of therapeutic GI endoscopy. Following a novel trend observed in many leading Endoscopy Units globally, Professor KL Goh decided to organise the 1<sup>st</sup> Live GI Endoscopy workshop in UMMC in 1993, in collaboration with the Malaysian Society of Gastroenterology and Hepatology (MSGH). The initial workshops were on a small scale, with CCTV cable transmissions from the Endoscopy Unit to a nearby lecture hall. The success of the first few workshops led to it becoming an annual feature of the MSGH events. The scale of the workshops grew as well, from just a one-day, one expert event to that of a three-day, "many experts" event with advanced digital video transmission technology, making it a model for Live Endoscopy workshops in not just the region but globally as well. In recognition of these successful workshops, together with other academic activities, the UMMC Endoscopy Unit was awarded the "Centre of Excellence" award by the World Endoscopy Organization (WEO) in 2008, an award which it still holds until today!

It is my great pleasure to introduce Professor Dr Krish Rangunath who is our distinguished lecturer for the Goh Khean Lee Distinguished Endoscopy lecture 2023.

Professor Dr Krish Rangunath is Professor of Medicine at Curtin University Medical School and a Consultant Gastroenterologist at the Royal Perth Hospital, Western Australia. He currently chairs the World Endoscopy Organization (WEO) Research committee and sits in the British Society of Gastroenterology (BSG) Endoscopy Research steering group and actively promoting high quality research globally.

He is also a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of London and Edinburgh as well as the American Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (FASGE) and the Japan Gastroenterological Endoscopy Society (JGES). He is currently a member of many local and international societies which include BSG, ASGE, ESGE and has been conferred honorary member of the South African GI Society. He has served as the BSG international secretary between 2014 and 2018, treasurer of BSG Endoscopy committee from 2016 to 2019, advisor for National Institute of Clinical Excellence (NICE) interventional procedures subgroup and also as an independent external advisor for the Welsh National Bowel Cancer screening programme.

Professor Dr Krish Rangunath is a key opinion leader in the field of Barrett's oesophagus and minimally invasive endoscopic therapy of early GI neoplasia. He has co-edited the BSG Barrett's oesophagus guidelines, guidelines for the management of gastric premalignant conditions and UK oesophageal dilatation guidelines. He has authored and co-authored more than 150 peer reviewed publications and text book chapters. He is an associate editor of 'Digestive Endoscopy', member of the Editorial Board for 'Endoscopy', 'Gastrointestinal Endoscopy', 'Gastrointestinal Nursing' and 'Translational Gastroenterology & Hepatology' journals.

It is not surprising then that Professor Dr Krish Rangunath has been bestowed with numerous awards and recognitions for his work in the field of gastroenterology including the BSG Hopkins Endoscopy Prize 2010. He also delivered the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh Professor Anne Ferguson lecture and was the recipient of the medal in 2017. He is a regular invited faculty for many national and international gastroenterology conferences such as DDW, UEGW, AGW and APDW. He has performed several live endoscopy demonstrations, endoscopy training in animal models and has lectured in national and international meetings.

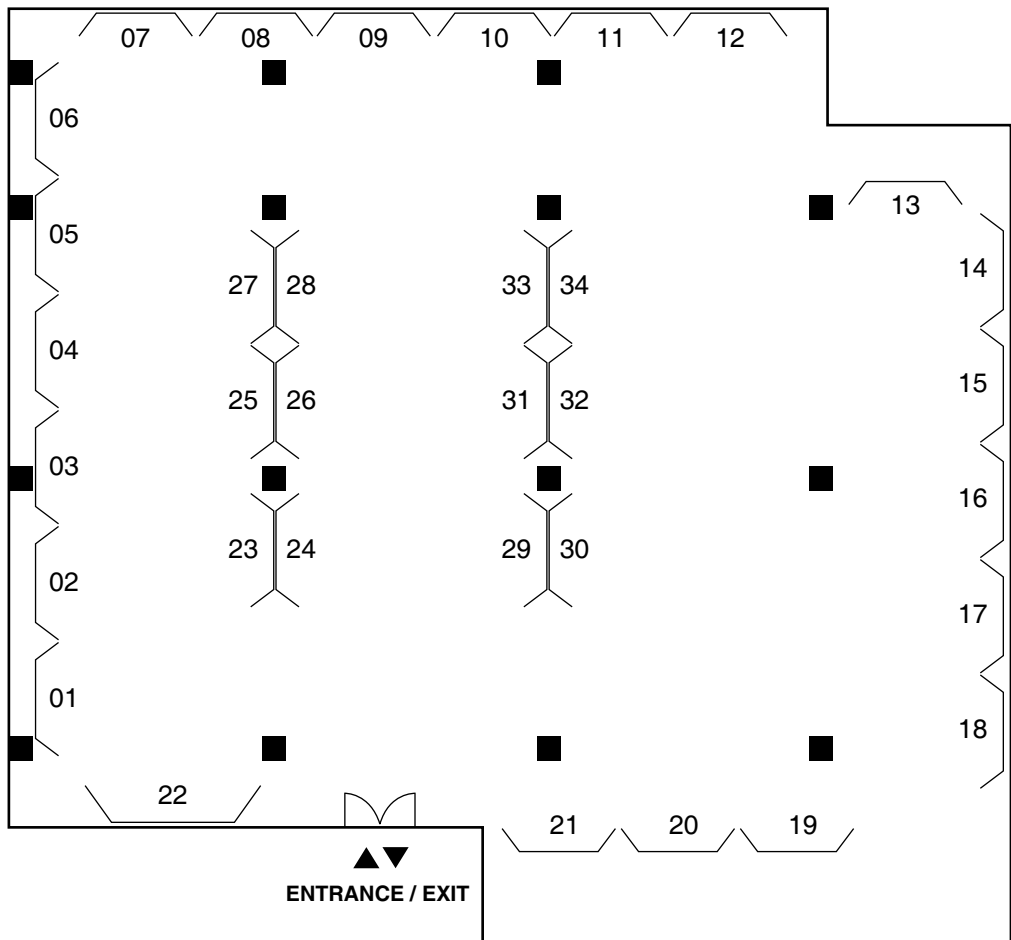
