Welcome to Endoscopy 2011 with the theme “What’s new and what’s good for our patients”.



Emphasis on therapeutic endoscopy: technique, indications limitations and pitfalls. In particular, in this year's workshop, we will be introducing several new sophisticated procedures which we want our participants to learn, appreciate their utility but at the same, to be critical about its application and usefulness in our daily clinical practice.

Dr Chiu is an expert therapeutic endoscopist. He runs the GI screening clinic at the National Taiwan University Hospital, Taipei, where he carries out more than 10,000 colonoscopies every year. He is an expert at detecting early flat and depressed colorectal neoplasms and is a key member of the Asian Pacific Working Party on Colorectal Cancer.

Dr Kaffes is a man for all seasons. A top-notch therapeutic endoscopist, Dr Kaffes spent a year's sabbatical in the Asian Institute of Gastroenterology in Hyderabad, India. He is an adept at ERCP, endoscopic ultrasonography, colonoscopy and enteroscopy where he is an expert in both the single and double balloon technique. He is also a well-known expert in bariatric endoscopy techniques. Dr Kaffes has also been a mentor and trainer for numerous GI fellows from Malaysia.

Professor Tajiri is currently Chairman and Professor in the Division of Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Department of Internal Medicine and also Professor in the Department of Endoscopy at The Jikei University School of Medicine, Tokyo, Japan. He graduated from Hokkaido University School of Medicine in Sapporo, Japan, in 1976, and received postgraduate professional training at the Department of Internal Medicine at Cancer Institute Hospital and the Endoscopy Division at National Cancer Center Hospital in Tokyo. In 1990, he was appointed Assistant Professor of the Second Department of Internal Medicine at National Defence Medical College, and in 1995, he joined National Cancer Center Hospital East, as the Chief of the Endoscopy Division.

Professor Tajiri's specialty and research interests are gastrointestinal endoscopy, as well as biliary and pancreatic diseases. His recent achievements are developments of various new endoscopic diagnosis and treatment for the GI malignancies using narrow band imaging (NBI) system, magnifying endoscopy, fluorescence endoscopy, endoscopic submucosal dissection (ESD) and Natural Orifice Translumenal Endoscopic Surgery (NOTES).

He has been active as Chair of International Committee in Japan Gastroenterological Endoscopy Society (JGES), Chair of Japan NOTES, and a member of the WGO/WEO Joint Education and Training Committee of the World Gastroenterology Organization. In addition, he has been active as a steering committee member of International Congress of Endoscopy (ICE 2011), a council member of Asian Pacific Digestive Week (APDW), and director of Endoscopy Master Forum.

Professor Tajiri has been awarded several times for his distinguished research achievements, and received the Japanese Cancer Association Award in 1987, the Japan Pancreas Society Award in 1991, Japan Gastroenterological Endoscopy Society Award in 1984, Tamiya's Memorial Award (Memorial Award of the First President, National Cancer Center) in 1998, "Crystal Award" (Honorary Member Award) from ASGE in 2007, "Uehara" Memorial Award in 2008, Princess Takamatsu Cancer Research Fund Prize in 2010. He has published more than 750 papers (205 of them in international journals).

Professor Tajiri organized the 79th Japan Gastroenterological Endoscopy Society and the 9th Korea-Japan Joint Symposium on Gastrointestinal Endoscopy as the President in Shinagawa, Tokyo, on May 13-15, 2010.

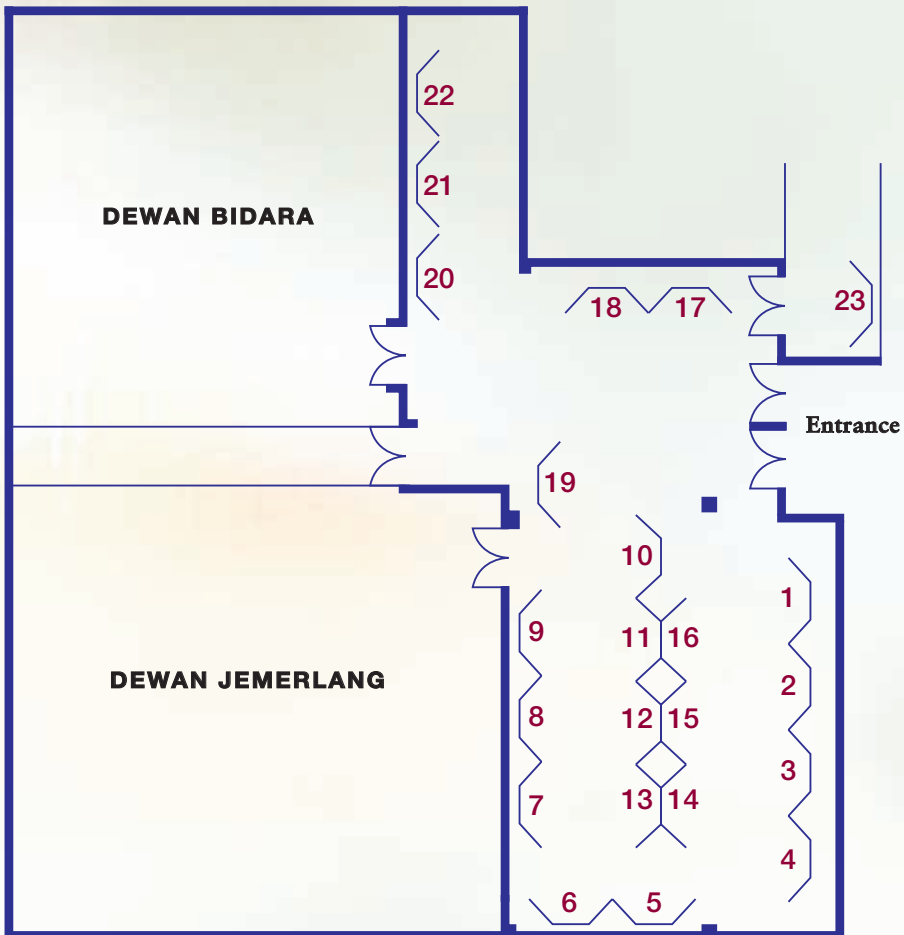

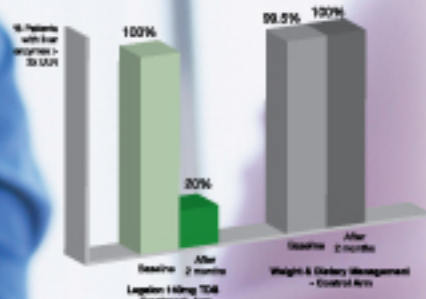
